Introduction

Hostax LLC and our affiliates (hereinafter, collectively, "**Hostax**", "**Company**", "**we**," "**us**," or "**our**") has created this privacy statement ("Privacy Policy") for the users of our website ("you" or "your") and to demonstrate our firm commitment to your privacy.

This Privacy Policy describes the types of personal information we may collect from or about you through our website and our practices for collecting, using, storing, maintaining, protecting and disclosing that information. For example, this Privacy Policy applies to information that you may provide when you visit our website located at www.hos.tax and when you use our services through our website (the "Website"). While this Privacy Policy describes how we treat personal information we collect from the Website, please be aware that additional terms and conditions may apply to the use of the Website.

This Policy does not apply to information collected by any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or on the Website.

Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this Policy. Children Under the Age of 13

Information We Collect About You

Information you provide to us. We may collect personal information about you when you provide it to us while registering for an account or using or interacting with the Website. You may be required to register in order to be granted access to certain information or services on the Website.

We may collect the following personal information when you provide it to us:

- Your mailing address;

- Account and other log in information; and
- Payment and other financial information, if you use any portion of the Website for the exchange of payments.

We may also receive messages or content you submit that contain personal information when you use the Website, as well as other information that may personally identify you that you submit to us. If you use, sign up, apply, or enroll for our services, we may collect such information.

Information we receive from other sources. From time to time, we may also receive information about you from our third-party service providers, customers, and partners.

We may also collect information about you from publicly available sources, including on public areas of the Website, or transmitted to other groups or users of the Website or third parties.

How We Use Your Information

The personal information that you provide to Company may be stored, processed, and used by Company and its affiliates for the following purposes:

- To present our Website and its contents to you;
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us, including updates, notifications, and other details;
- To provide you with notices about your account;
- To assist us in improving our products, services, or the content of the Website;
